**Gateway seeking applicants
for board seats due to expire**

KENOSHA – Gateway Technical College is seeking applicants for three district board of trustee seats due to expire July 1.

The application period began February 21 and will close noon March 11. One Kenosha County seat and two Racine County seats make up the three seats. Among those three, one appointee must be an elected official and the other two will be designated as additional members.

Those holding the seats up for reappointment are Ram Bhatia, Roger Zacharias and Pamela Zenner-Richards. The three-year appointments begin July 1, 2008, and end June 30, 2011.

The appointment committee will conduct interviews beginning at 5 p.m., April 2, in Room 100 of Gateway's Burlington Center, 496 McCanna Parkway in Burlington. If needed, the group will also meet April 3 at the same location. Chairpersons of the Kenosha County, Racine County and Walworth County boards of supervisors make up the interview committee. Michael Miklasevich,

chairperson of the Racine County Board of Supervisors, is the chairperson of the Gateway Technical College District Board Appointment Committee.
