## Deadline approaching for Gateway's

## Martin Luther King Jr. Humanitarian Award

The deadline for submitting nominations for Gateway's Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Humanitarian Award is 4:30 p.m. Wednesday Dec. 1.

Honorees will be recognized at Gateway Technical College's 17<sup>th</sup> Annual Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Celebration program noon January 17.

The honorees will receive an award at the annual event for exemplifying the daily principles of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. and serving the causes of equality, justice, freedom and peace.

To qualify for the honor, recipients need to be residents of Kenosha, Racine or Walworth counties. Other criteria include ensuring equal opportunity and career advancement options for underrepresented ethnic groups, demonstrating a strong and growing commitment to service and serving as a role model for disadvantaged or underrepresented groups.
