## Gateway hosts statewide Microsoft Al train-the-trainer event

Gateway Technical College hosted a Microsoft train-the-trainer Artificial Intelligence Bootcamp for Educators event at its SC Johnson iMET Center in Sturtevant on Thursday, July 11, an event that marks one of the many steps taken by Microsoft to invest in Wisconsin and its economy.

As part of Microsoft's Al Skills initiative, Microsoft is offering curriculum, resources and training to support faculty and educators who provide – or are interested in providing – training and enablement for student Al skilling.
