

Financial Aid

Gateway's Financial Aid department ensures access to higher education by awarding financial aid according to federal financial aid guidelines to students who do not have the family resources.

Students may be eligible for financial aid if:

- Student resources (savings, earnings, parental contribution) are less than the cost of attendance at Gateway. Cost of attendance includes; tuition and fees, books and supplies, room and board, transportation, and personal expenses for associate degree and technical diploma programs.
- The student is enrolled in an eligible program.
- The student is registered for at least six credits worth of classes during a semester.
- The student is a U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen.

Gateway encourages all students to apply for financial aid. You can apply for financial aid throughout the year; however, to ensure your aid is processed before the start of term, follow the priority application dates below.

Summer Semester: Apply by March 1
Fall Semester: Apply by July 1
Spring Semester: Apply by November 1

Paying for College

Gateway is eager to assist you in making college affordable through federal and state financial aid programs, a Student Payment Plan, Veteran Education Benefit programs, employer-sponsored reimbursement, third-party agency funding, and Gateway Foundation and other scholarships. Gateway's tuition and fees are set by the Wisconsin Technical College System Board each year. This brochure details the estimated cost by program.

Options for paying for college can include any one or a combination of the following:

Financial Aid

Financial aid helps students of any age meet educational costs. Financial aid may be in the form of federal and/or state grants, federal work-study, and/or federal student loans. Student loans must be repaid.

Student Payment Plan

The Student Payment Plan is available for students taking three or more eligible credits. Students can enroll in the plan at the time of registering for classes with no money down and no fee required. All payment plans are set up with four equal payments, with the first payment being due the first Friday of the semester.

Veterans Benefits

The majority of programs offered by Gateway are approved for U.S. Department of Veteran Affairs educational benefits. Benefits are available through the Wisconsin Department of Veteran Affairs and/or the U.S. Department of Veteran Affairs. Information is available at gtc.edu/va.

Employer Tuition Reimbursement Program

Often employers will reimburse part or all of a student's tuition. Check with your employer's Human Resources office for details on available programs at your workplace.

Third-Party Authorizations

Authorizations for payment from a third party must be sent directly to the Student Accounts department. Third-party authorizations may include: employer, DVR, TAA, WFDC, OIC, community agencies or scholarships.

Scholarships

Scholarships are available each year, including specific high school and continuing student scholarships, through the Gateway Technical College Foundation and outside sources. Information, deadlines, and applications are available at gtc.edu/scholarships.
