



## CLEP Exams accepted at Gateway Technical College

**To receive proficiency college credit:**

1. Students must be accepted into an associate’s degree, technical diploma, certificate, or apprenticeship program at Gateway.
2. Submit official (unopened) CLEP scores directly from CollegeBoard to Gateway Technical College.
3. A minimum score of 50, or higher in some cases, is required on all accepted CLEP exams listed below.

Gateway accepts all CLEP exams with a score of 50 or better (unless another score is noted below). For all other CLEP exams offered but not listed in the table below with a direct equivalent Gateway course, three associate degree level elective credits will be awarded, which can fulfill required program elective credits
