AmeriCorps is a program of CNCS, a federal agency whose mission is to improve lives, strengthen communities, and foster civic engagement through service and volunteering.

The WiCC AmeriCorps program is a community service opportunity for currently enrolled college students to serve with local non-profit agencies to increase capacity building for these partner organizations. AmeriCorps members will assist in recruiting and managing volunteers, improving volunteer management practices, and conduct community impact assessment to improve the performance of these community organizations. Through this work, members will gain work experience that is both *versatile* and *valuable*.

- Members serve 450 hours by August 14, 2015 and receive a \$1,500 Educational Award
- Members will receive support and training from both their site supervisor and Service Learning Center Staff.
- Members are required to check-in monthly with a progress report at monthly trainings.

Kenosha County UW-Extension – Kenosha
