# 2016 UW Parkside/Gateway Technical College Scholarship Application

#### **ELIGIBILITY RULES** (please read to make sure you are eligible before applying):

- 1. Student must be a senior in a Racine area high school and expected to graduate at the end the 2015 2016 school year.
- 2. Student must attend UW Parkside or Gateway Technical College in the fall of 2016 (scholarship is only valid for these two local colleges).
- 3. Minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) required at the end of the first semester of senior year is 3.0 for students planning to attend UW Parkside and 2.5 for students attending Gateway.
- 4. Up to nine scholarships will be awarded five \$1,000 and four \$500 scholarships will be given to selected students based on academic record, commitment to learning and community service activities (minimum of 1 to 2 Gateway scholarships will be awarded).
- 5. Students must be available for short interview between 5 pm to 9 pm of Tuesday, April 5<sup>th</sup>. Qualified candidates will be contacted approximately one week prior to schedule times.

#### **REQUIREMENTS** (must follow these details to be considered for this scholarship):

- 1. Complete this application form and return by Monday, March 28th.
- 2. Provide two letters of recommendation from a teacher, counselor and/or community leaders
- 3. Provide a copy of student transcript through the first semester of senior year
