Certificate: NAIL TECHNICIAN (90-502-1)

Credits: 9 Credits

Description: This certificate provides instruction in basic and advanced nail techniques including application of acrylic, fiberglass, silk, and gel nails. Courses are theory, practical, and client services centered, and allow students to prepare for the Wisconsin State Board Exam. There is a separate kit required for each course.

Certificate: RETAIL BEAUTY ADVISOR (61-502-1)

Credits: 4 Credits

Description: The Retail Beauty Advisor Certificate is designed to prepare students for entry level positions as a retail beauty consultant/advisor. This course includes theory and practical training in facial massage, skin care, basic and corrective makeup application, eyebrow arching, waxing, and seasonal color analysis and is designed to help the student understand business principles, customer service, salesmanship, and philosophy of business objectives for salons.
