


Who is Gateway Technical College?

Degree Types

QCERTIFICATE (typically six months or less)

Entry-level credential for quick employment gains

TECHNICAL DIPLOMA (one- to two-year programs)

- Real-world programs created with employer input
- >> Typically one to two years to complete full time

ASSOCIATE DEGREE (two-year programs)

- Academic degree with a focus on hard and soft skills
- >> Typically two years to complete full time
- May build on earlier credentials (certificates, degrees and diplomas)

APPRENTICESHIP (journeyworker status)

- Employers pay for supervised, structured on-the-job training and classroom learning
- Prepares skilled tradespeople to enter the workforce (with a median salary of \$71,624/year six months after completion)

College Savings

TUINON AND FEES

Tuition is consistent at the 16 technical colleges and costs less than other colleges and universities. Effective with the 2018 summer session:

WISCONSIN RESIDENT

DEGREE AND DIPLOMA PROGRAM: \$134.20 PER CREDIT

FOUR-YEAR COLLEGE/LIBERAL ARTS TRANSFER PROGRAM:

\$181.50 PER CREDIT

OUT-OF-STATE RESIDENT

DEGREE AND DIPLOMA PROGRAM: >> \$201.30 PER CREDIT FOUR-YEAR COLLEGE/LIBERAL ARTS TRANSFER PROGRAM:

» \$272.25 PER CREDIT
