# What does research identify as benefits of Dual Credit

- Taking college courses in high school can increase the chances that both advantage & disadvantaged students go to college and earn a degree.
- Dual enrollment students are 11% more likely to persist through the second year of college than non-participating students.
- Dual enrollment students are 12% more likely to enter college within seven months of high school graduation than non-participating students.
- 88% of community college dual enrollment students continued in college after high school, and most earned a degree or transferred within six years.
