Become a Certified Nursing Assistant



To qualify for a testing voucher, you must:

- Be a high school student in grades 10-12 from Racine, Kenosha or Walworth counties
- Successfully complete Gateway's Nursing Assistant course in Fall 2018, Spring 2019, Summer 2019, Fall 2019 or Spring 2020
- Complete the High School Student Certifications: Student Registration Information form
- Attend a Nursing Assistant Skills Test Prep Course (see instructor for details)
- Be taking the exam for the first time – re-takes are not covered
- Take the exam within 60 days of completing the Nursing Assistant course – testing must be completed by June 1, 2020, and you are responsible for scheduling your own test session
- Complete a Post-Program Completion survey

Students will have an opportunity to earn the following industry recognized certifications listed on CTE Incentive Grant Class of 2019 list:

- **Wisconsin Technical College System Technical Diploma:** 30-543-1 Nursing Assistant
- **Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS):** Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA)
