Gateway Technical College will host a criminal justice job fair, featuring more than 30 recruiters from Wisconsin and Illinois municipalities as well as state and federal agencies, 1 p.m. to 6 p.m. Oct. 21 in HARIBO Hall at the Madrigrano Conference Center of the college's Kenosha Campus, 3520-30th Ave.

While the job fair will help Gateway Law Enforcement Academy students to connect with possible future employers, Amy Koeppel, Gateway Director of Law Enforcement Training, says the large event is also open to the public and encourages anyone considering a career in law enforcement, criminal justice or legal fields to participate.
