Gateway to host 17th annual holiday gifting & art fair

More than 140 vendors will feature arts, crafts and specialty products ideal for holiday shoppers at Gateway Technical College's annual Holiday Gifting and Art Fair fundraiser 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Dec. 14 at the college's Kenosha Campus, 3520-30th Ave.

The popular event is free and open to the public.

The event features an array of items, including original arts and crafts, jewelry, clothing, holiday décor, and home and yard art. Home-based vendors will also be on hand, and food will be available for purchase as well.

There will be an opportunity for children to visit with Santa and have free photos taken with him from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. halfway down the Technical Building hallway on the west side of the show.

The college's student Horticulture club will also be selling hand-painted ornamental amaryllis bulbs. One important note this year is that strollers will not be allowed inside the gifting show because of the crowded nature of the event and safety concerns.

The fair will fill the majority of the Student Commons and the Technical, Science, Service and Academic Building corridors.

These buildings are located on the southeastern end of the campus, right off 30th Avenue. The event is sponsored as a fundraiser for the Gateway Technical College Foundation's student emergency fund.
