Gateway to hold workshop on Eastern bluebirds

Gateway Technical College's Center for Sustainable Living on its Kenosha Campus, 3520-30th Ave., will be the site of a free workshop on ways to attract the Eastern bluebird to backyard bird feeders and bird houses.

Well-known local bird expert Rick Fare will lead the workshop to be held 4:30 p.m. to 6 p.m. March 25.

Attendees will learn the best places to place their nest boxes as well as traits of the bird and how best to attract them to an urban or suburban backyard. Many bluebirds will nest in boxes built for them along a bluebird trail which helped in their recovery last century.
