Description

The purpose of this degree completion agreement is to provide a seamless transfer process for learners at Gateway Technical College who desire further education to enter Mount Mary College. Through the collaborative efforts of faculty, student services, and administration, learners will encounter a clear path to reach their educational goals.

Requirements for Certificate Entry

- WTCS Application for Admission
- Official high school, GED, or HSED transcript, including a graduation or passing date
- ACT or SAT or Gateway placement assessments (writing, reading, and math skills) if applicable
- Official college transcripts if applicable (students submitting official college transcripts to Gateway will also need to submit transcripts to Mount Mary College if requested)

Certificate Requirements

Gateway students must fulfill the following requirements to receive a General Studies Transfer Certificate from Gateway:

1. Attain math competency - Math competency can be fulfilled by achieving a passing score on a competency test at Mount Mary College, or by earning a grade of C or better in the following math course at Gateway Technical College:

804-197 College Algebra & Trigonometry w/ Apps.
2. Complete 801-136 English Composition 1.
3. Complete a minimum of 27 credits (including math required for competency) from the Mount Mary College Core Transfer List on the following page.

Students *may* complete additional courses from the Core Transfer List in this agreement up to a maximum of 64 credits prior to admission to Mount Mary College.

Students are encouraged to consult an advisor at Mount Mary College to assist in selecting appropriate courses.

NOTE: Students must complete a certificate program with a minimum of a 2.0 Program GPA.
